**getline** function reads from the current input pointer to a delimiter, including it (the default delimiter is `\n`, the end-of-line character), and returns everything except the delimiter.

The **cin** function skips the leading whitespace (if present) and reads until the next trailing whitespace (including the new line character), but leaves the trailing whitespace.

Therefore, the first **getline** statement in the provided code will get an empty string.
